## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 100

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 CLINTON HIGH SCHOOL LADY ARROWS BASKETBALL TEAM, HEAD COACH  
3 FELICIA LOFTON AND ASSISTANT COACH AMANDA HATCH FOR THEIR  
4 PHENOMENAL 2005-2006 SEASON AND FOR WINNING THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH  
5 SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION CLASS 5A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.
