A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING ALPHA PHI ALPHA 1 FRATERNITY, INC., ON THE OCCASION OF ITS CENTENNIAL ANNIVERSARY 2 3 CELEBRATION. 4 WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., was founded on December 4, 1906, and is the first and oldest intercollegiate 5 Greek-letter foundation established for African Americans; and 6 WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha was founded at Cornell University by 7 8 seven college men who recognized the need for a strong bond of brotherhood among African-American descendants in this country; 9 10 and WHEREAS, founded by visionaries, known as the "Jewels" of the 11 12 Fraternity: Henry Arthur Callis, Charles Henry Chapman, Eugene 13 Kinckle Jones, George Biddle Kelley, Nathaniel Allison Murray, Robert Harold Ogle and Vertner Woodson Tandy; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha initially served as a study and support group for minority students who faced racial prejudice, 16 both educationally and socially, that originally met at 421 North 17 18 Albany Street, Ithaca, New York, and was incorporated January 29, 1908; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the Jewel founders and early leaders of the 21 fraternity succeeded in laying a firm foundation for Alpha Phi

22 Alpha's principles of scholarship, fellowship, good character and 23 the uplifting of humanity; and

24 WHEREAS, after developing chapters at other colleges and 25 universities, many being historically black institutions, Alpha 26 Phi Alpha continues to proliferate, spanning the globe with some 27 800 chapters, more than 160,000 members worldwide located
