HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 20

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE VITAL ROLE OF THE AMERICAN 1 STROKE ASSOCIATION AND URGING THE MISSISSIPPI LEGISLATURE TO ENACT 2 3 LEGISLATION TO ESTABLISH A SYSTEM OF STROKE CARE IN THE STATE. 4 WHEREAS, according to the American Stroke Association, a division of the American Heart Association, strokes are the third 5 leading cause of death in the United States striking about 700,000 6 7 Americans each year; and 8 WHEREAS, stroke is a leading cause of serious long-term disability in the United States with 4.8 million stroke survivors 9 10 today; and WHEREAS, in 2004, the estimated direct and indirect cost of 11 12 stroke is about \$53.6 billion; and 13 WHEREAS, the Institute of Medicine (IOM) of the National Academy of Science has concluded that the fragmentation of the 14 15 delivery of health care services frequently results in suboptimal treatment, safety concerns and inefficient use of health care 16

17 resources; and

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18 WHEREAS, the IOM recommended the establishment of coordinated 19 systems of care that integrate preventative and treatment services 20 and promote patient access to evidence-based care resources; and WHEREAS, according to the American Stroke Association

22 research, a systems approach is necessary to effectuate true change in the way stroke is treated statewide so that patients 23 have access to the most advanced treatment in centers that are 24 best designed and equipped to deal with the critical and time 25 26 sensitive needs of stroke patients; and

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WHEREAS, the main purpose of stroke systems legislation is to 27 28 establish a systems approach to dealing with stroke patients including assessing center designations, EMS protocols and field 29 30 triage, inter-facility stroke transfer and stroke data collection: 31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That the Legislature 32 of the State of Mississippi is called upon to work toward the 33 passage of legislation that will establish a system of stroke care 34 for all residents stricken by stroke. 35

36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be 37 furnished to the local American Heart Association affiliate, the 38 Chairmen of the House and Senate Public Health and Welfare 39 Committees and to the members of the Capitol Press Corps.
