27 only participating in the State Games but by winning the coveted  
28 gold medal for the one-mile run; and

30 recognize and commend a remarkable and determined young person  
31 such as Jennifer Harper who demonstrates that no matter the age of  
32 an individual, with persistence any challenge can be conquered:
