HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 77

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE OF MRS. BERTHA MAE PAYNE AND
2 EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY UPON HER PASSING.

4 Mary Irene Robinson Ball and Mr. Payton Ball in Holmes County,
5 Mississippi, and departed this life in 2006;

6 WHEREAS, a native Mississippian, Mrs. Payne received her
7 educational training at Spring Valley Public Schools in Cruger,
8 Mississippi; and

9 WHEREAS, her spiritual needs were served while she was a
10 member of New Jerusalem M.B. Church in Itta Bena, Mississippi; and

11 WHEREAS, Mrs. Payne wed twice during her lifetime; and

12 WHEREAS, she was united in holy matrimony to her first
13 husband, Mr. Herbert Williams, in 1928; and

14 WHEREAS, later in life, she wed her second husband in holy
15 matrimony, Mr. Jessie Payne, Sr., in 1946; and

16 WHEREAS, she is survived by 11 children; and

17 WHEREAS, Mrs. Payne was sadly preceded in death by two of her
18 children; and

19 WHEREAS, her family and many friends will cherish the
20 memories they experienced with Mrs. Payne while she was on earth;

22 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
