HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 95

1 A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING THE HIRAM LODGE NO.17  
2 ON THE OCCASION OF ITS 128TH ANNIVERSARY AND ITS FIRST ANNUAL  
3 FOUNDER'S DAY AND HOMECOMING CELEBRATION ON MARCH 28, 2006.

4 WHEREAS, Sunday, March 26, 2006, will commemorate the Hiram  
5 Lodge No. 17's First Annual Founder's Day and Homecoming  
6 Celebration in the organization's 128th year of existence; and

7 WHEREAS, in the fall of 1878, Hiram Lodge opened its doors in  
8 West Point, Mississippi, opening as the seventeenth lodge in the  
9 State of Mississippi, with the intended purpose of disseminating  
10 charity, promoting the spirit of brotherly love, teaching and  
11 encouraging the ideas of peace, harmony and goodwill among people  
12 and loyalty to our state and country; and

13 WHEREAS, though some of the historical record is bleak,  
14 research and oral interpretations have allowed some records to be  
15 collected, such as the 54th and 78th Communications of the Most  
16 Worshipful Stringer Grand Lodge Hiram in the years of 1929 and  
17 1953 respectively; and

18 WHEREAS, from old minute books, pertinent information was  
19 collected giving the last account of the last 47 years' activities  
20 and Worshipful Masters; and

21 WHEREAS, the legacy of great works continues with current  
22 Worshipful Master, Jordan McFarland, leading lodge members in  
23 their pursuit of excellence through more community based programs;

25 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to  
26 commend the excellent efforts of such esteemed organizations as  
27 the Hiram Lodge No. 17, whose works of promoting scholarship,

28 etiquette and community enrichment are monumental in the West  
29 Point, Mississippi, community:
