HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 113

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING LIEUTENANT
2 TERENCE C. SARGENT UPON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT AFTER
3 TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THE WAYNESBORO POLICE
4 DEPARTMENT.

5 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Terence C. Sargent has announced his
6 pending retirement from the Waynesboro Police Department after 25
7 years of dedicated service; and

8 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Terence Sargent is a 1984 graduate of the
9 Laurel Law Enforcement Training Academy, the Traveling Criminal
10 Apprehension Program and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI)
11 SWAT School in Tuscaloosa, Alabama; and

12 WHEREAS, as evidence of his commitment to law enforcement,
13 Lieutenant Sargent is the 2006 Sergeant of Guard for the
14 Waynesboro Fraternal Order of Police for Waynesboro Lodge No. 7
15 and has held that position since 1994; and

16 WHEREAS, the lieutenant's dedication to the public extends
17 beyond the police department into summer programs in the City of
18 Waynesboro where he has coached youth baseball and basketball over
19 the years; and

20 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
21 recognize the public service of outstanding individuals such as
22 Lieutenant Terence C. Sargent whose dedication and commitment have
23 brought honor to himself, the Waynesboro Police Department, the
24 City of Waynesboro and the State of Mississippi:

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
26 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
27 commend and congratulate Lieutenant Terence C. Sargent upon the
