HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 120

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MAY 2, 2006, AS WORLD ASTHMA DAY. 1 2 WHEREAS, asthma has reached epidemic proportions in the United States, affecting about 20 million people; and 3 WHEREAS, asthma is the leading cause of childhood 4 hospitalizations, long-term illness, and school absenteeism, 5 accounting for more than 14 million missed school days each year; 6 7 and WHEREAS, each year two million people are rushed to the 8 emergency room and over 4,000 people die from asthma; and 9 WHEREAS, asthma is a long-term, inflammatory disease in which 10 11 the airways of the lungs constrict, causing wheezing, 12 breathlessness, chest tightness and coughing; and WHEREAS, exposure to allergens and irritants such as dust 13 14 mites, mold, cockroaches, pet dander and secondhand smoke can 15 bring on an asthma episode; and WHEREAS, secondhand smoke worsens children's asthma in up to 16 17 one million children; and 18 WHEREAS, there are simple steps people can take to reduce 19 their exposure to environmental asthma; and 20 WHEREAS, the American Lung Association, the Mississippi 21 Department of Health and the United States Environmental 22 Protection Agency are encouraging Americans to identify and reduce their exposures to environmental triggers in homes and schools, 23 and incorporate environmental controls into their asthma 24 25 management plans; and
