SENATE BILL NO. 2041

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT COMPUTER-ASSISTED REMOTE HUNTING; TO 1 PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR SUCH HUNTING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. (1) For purposes of this section: 5 (a) "Computer-assisted remote hunting" means the use of a computer or any other device, equipment or software to remotely 6 7 control the aiming and discharge of archery equipment, firearms or 8 primitive firearms to take any game animal or bird. 9 "Facility for computer-assisted remote hunting" (b) means the real property and improvements on the property to 10 11 facilitate computer-assisted remote hunting. (2) (a) It is unlawful for a person to engage in 12 computer-assisted remote hunting. 13 (b) It is unlawful for a person to provide or operate a 14 15 facility for computer-assisted remote hunting if the game animal or bird being hunted is located in this state. 16 (3) A person violating this section is guilty of a Class I 17 offense and shall be punished as provided under Section 49-7-141. 18 Each game animal or bird killed in the violation of this section 19 20 is a separate offense. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 21 22 and after July 1, 2006.
