1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A JOINT STUDY COMMITTEE ON THE CRITICAL NEEDS OF NURSING FACULTY AT THE MISSISSIPPI INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING AND THE COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES; TO REQUIRE A REPORT TO THE 2007 REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> (1) There is created a Joint Study Committee on
8	the Critical Needs of Nursing Faculty at the Mississippi
9	Institutions of Higher Learning and the Community and Junior
10	Colleges. The joint committee shall study alternative programs to
11	produce more nursing faculty at the schools of nursing in
12	Mississippi in order to fill the health care needs of this state.
13	The Joint committee shall, at a minimum, study and report to the
14	2007 Regular Session of the Legislature on the following:
15	(a) Salary supplements to nurse faculty;
16	(b) Employer-assisted housing for nurse faculty
17	programs, including home loans to nurse educators and relocation

(d) Authorize advanced degree students to pursue 21

expenses to nurses who agree to become nursing faculty;

(c) Annual program supplements for each RN program in

- 22 masters and doctoral degrees in nursing with payback if they

- (e) Earmark IHL scholarship/loan program for nursing 24

- The Joint Committee shall make a report of its findings and 26
- 27 recommendations to the Legislature by December 1, 2006, including

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- 29 (2) The joint committee shall be composed of the following
- 30 ten (10) members:
- 31 (a) The Chairmen of the Senate and House Appropriation
- 32 Committees;

- 35 (c) Three (3) Senators to be appointed by the
