- 6 RELOCATION EXPENSES TO NURSES WHO AGREE TO BECOME NURSING FACULTY; 7 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** The following provision shall be codified as
- 10 Section 37-143-10, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 11 37-143-10. (1) There is established a "Mississippi Critical
- 12 Needs Nursing Faculty Incentive Program." This program shall be
- 13 implemented by the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
- 14 Higher Learning and the State Board for Community and Junior
- 15 Colleges to produce more nursing faculty at the schools of nursing
- 16 in Mississippi in order to fill the health care needs of this
- 17 state.
- 18 (2) Pursuant to specific appropriation therefor by the
- 19 Legislature, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher
- 20 Learning shall implement a three-year across-the-board salary
- 21 increase of not less than Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) nor
- 22 more than Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) in fiscal year 2007,
- 23 fiscal year 2008 and fiscal year 2009 for all registered nurses
- 24 who are faculty in approved undergraduate and graduate nursing
- 25 programs in the state. Pursuant to specific appropriation
- 26 therefor by the Legislature, the State Board for Community and
- 27 Junior Colleges shall implement a three-year across-the-board
- 28 salary increase of not less than Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00)
- 29 nor more than Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) in fiscal year

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2007, fiscal year 2008 and fiscal year 2009 for all registered 30 31 nurses who are faculty in approved associate degree nursing 32 programs in the state. This incentive is intended to bring 33 salaries for nursing faculty within the average for the geographic 34 area in which the State of Mississippi competes for nursing 35 faculty. Salary supplements under this subsection shall be 36 allocated to nursing faculty who enter into contract with the appropriate school of nursing obligating themselves to spend a 37 period of time of not less than three (3) years in teaching 38 nursing at any accredited school of nursing in Mississippi. 39 40 person who does not render three (3) years' service as a nursing faculty in an approved school of nursing in Mississippi under this 41 program, shall be liable to the appropriate board for one-third 42 (1/3) of the total amount of the salary supplement granted under 43 the program for each year that the person does not render such 44 service, plus interest accruing at the current Stafford Loan rate 45 46 at the time the person discontinues his service. If a claim for 47 repayment under this subsection is placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, the obligor shall be liable for an 48 49 additional amount equal to a reasonable attorney's fee. The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning and the State 50 51 Board for Community and Junior Colleges shall jointly establish such rules and regulations as deemed necessary and proper to carry 52 out the purposes and intent of this subsection. 53 54 There is established the Mississippi Employer-Assisted Housing Program for Nursing Faculty which shall be a special home 55

56 loan program for any eligible registered nurse who renders service 57 on the faculty in an approved undergraduate and graduate nursing 58 program or associate degree nursing program in Mississippi. 59 home loan program shall be administered by the Board of Trustees 60 of State Institutions of Higher Learning jointly with the State 61 Board for Community and Junior Colleges in conjunction with the 62 Federal National Mortgage Association (Fannie Mae). 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Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning and the State
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    Board for Community and Junior Colleges may contract with one or
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    more public or private entities to provide assistance in
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    implementing and administering the program, and shall adopt rules
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    and regulations regarding the implementation and administration of
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    this program. Participation in the loan program shall be
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    available to any registered nurse who renders service as faculty
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    in an approved school of nursing in the State of Mississippi. Any
    person who receives a loan under this program shall be required to
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    purchase a house located in the State of Mississippi and reside in
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    such house. The maximum amount of a loan that may be made under
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    this program to any person shall be Thirty Thousand Dollars
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    ($30,000.00). Any loan made under this program to a person who
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    actually renders service as a nurse faculty in an approved school
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    of nursing in Mississippi shall be converted to an interest-free
    grant on the basis of one (1) years' service for one-third (1/3)
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    of the amount of the loan. Any person who does not render three
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    (3) years' service as a nurse faculty in Mississippi shall be
    liable to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher
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    Learning and/or the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges
    for one-third (1/3) of the amount of the loan for each year the
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    person does not render such service, plus interest accruing at the
    current Stafford Loan rate at the time the person discontinues his

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          All funds received by the Board of Trustees of State
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    Institutions of Higher Learning or the State Board for Community
    and Junior Colleges as repayment of loans by program participants
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    shall be deposited in the Mississippi Critical Needs Nursing
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    Faculty Incentive Fund, hereby created in the State Treasury.
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              Subject to the availability of funds specifically
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    appropriated therefor by the Legislature, any registered nurse
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96 relocating to any geographical area of the State of Mississippi in 97 order to render service as a nursing faculty at an approved 98 undergraduate and graduate or associate degree nursing program 99 located within the state shall be eligible for reimbursement for 100 their moving expenses by the Board of Trustees of State 101 Institutions of Higher Learning or the State Board for Community 102 and Junior Colleges, as the case may be. The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning jointly with the State Board 103 104 for Community and Junior Colleges shall promulgate rules and 105 regulations necessary for the administration of the relocation 106 expense reimbursement component of the Mississippi Critical Needs Nursing Faculty Incentive Program. As a condition for 107 108 participation in this component of the program, nursing faculty 109 shall agree to employment at the school of nursing for a period of 110 not less than three (3) years. Any person failing to comply with this employment commitment shall immediately be in breach of 111 112 contract and become liable immediately to the Board of Trustees of 113 State Institutions of Higher Learning or the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges, as the case may be, for the sum of 114 115 the relocation expenses granted to that person, less one-third (1/3) of the amount of that sum for each year that service was 116 rendered, plus interest accruing at the current Stafford Loan rate 117 at the time the breach occurs. If a claim for repayment under 118 119 this subsection is placed in the hands of an attorney for 120 collection after default, then the obligor shall be liable for an additional amount equal to a reasonable attorney's fee.
