- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. 5 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person, not
- being the owner thereof and without lawful authority, to willfully 6
- injure, disfigure, remove or destroy any Confederate historic 7
- 8 structure, Confederate monument, Confederate marker or Confederate
- 9 artifact.
- Any person violating any of the provisions of this 10
- section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, 11
- shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars 12
- 13 (\$500.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by
- imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such 14
- 15 fine and imprisonment. Each day of continued violation of any
- provision of this section shall constitute a distinct and separate 16
- offense for which the offender may be punished. 17
- 18 (3) The Board of Trustees of the Mississippi Department of
- Archives and History, at its discretion, may grant a "finder's 19
