SENATE BILL NO. 2268

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-1-98, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE FOR FLEXIBLE OFFICE HOURS FOR CERTAIN STATE AGENCIES AND 3 TO PROVIDE FOR STAFF DURING SUCH FLEXIBLE OFFICE HOURS; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 25-1-98, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

8 25-1-98. (1) In addition to any other times required by 9 statute, all state offices shall be open and staffed for the 10 normal conduct of business from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except on legal holidays as set forth in Section 11 3-3-7. The Governor may designate certain state offices and 12 institutions as providers of essential services and require that 13 they be open and staffed on legal holidays. The Board of 14 Directors of the Mississippi Industries for the Blind may, in its 15 16 discretion, require that its offices and operations be open and staffed on legal holidays. Employees required to work on legal 17 holidays shall earn compensatory leave under the provisions of 18 19 Section 25-3-92. No employee shall receive additional vacation or sick leave benefits for working on a legal holiday, nor shall this 20 21 section be construed to authorize any additional compensation as an alternative to the accrual of compensatory leave except as 22 23 specifically provided for in a legislative appropriation. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to limit the 24 hours of operation of any agency or to abrogate any action taken 25 26 during hours other than those stated, nor shall these provisions apply to any offices that do not customarily stay open five (5) 27 The provisions of this section shall not apply to 28 days a week. *SS01/R368* S. 29 the military department of the State of Mississippi or to the 30 armories, field training sites, air bases or other installations 31 of the Mississippi National Guard.

32 (2) A workday for a state employee in a full-time employment 33 position shall be eight (8) hours in duration at a minimum 34 exclusive of time off for meals. The appointing authority shall 35 develop work schedules which ensure that each full-time employee 36 works a full workday and shall provide the State Auditor with a 37 copy of the regular work schedule of the appointing authority.

38 (3) In addition to any other times required by statute, the 39 following state agencies shall be open and staffed for the normal conduct of business from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m., Monday through 40 Saturday: (a) the Department of Human Services; (b) the Division 41 of Medicaid; (c) the State Department of Health; and (d) the 42 Mississippi Department of Employment Security. The administrative 43 head of the appropriate divisions and bureaus of such agencies 44 45 shall assign employees to flexible working hours in order to accommodate the flexible office hours prescribed herein, and no 46 employee assigned to such flexible office hours shall receive 47 additional compensation, vacation leave or compensatory leave 48 benefits for staffing the office during such period of time. 49 50 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006. 51
