1 2 3	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-7-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE WITNESS APPEARANCE FEE IN STATE COURT; TO REVISE MILEAGE PAID TO WITNESSES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. Section 25-7-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6	amended as follows:
7	25-7-47. Witnesses in the county, circuit and chancery
8	courts shall receive a witness fee in the amount allowable to
9	witnesses in the federal courts and the mileage reimbursement rate
10	allowable to federal employees for the use of a privately-owned
11	vehicle while on official travel for each mile going to and
12	returning from the courthouse to their homes by the nearest route,
13	and such tolls and ferriages as they may actually be obliged to
14	pay; but mileage, toll and ferriage shall be charged but once at
15	each term of court, and a charge shall not be made for mileage
16	except that traveled in this state. Witnesses before a justice
17	court judge shall be allowed the federal witness appearance fee
18	per day and no more. Witnesses in all other cases shall receive
19	the same compensation as they receive before the circuit court.
20	It shall not be necessary to issue subpoenas for police officers
21	as witnesses in city cases of cities having a population of more
22	than ten thousand (10,000) according to the federal census of
23	1930; and such officers, when used as witnesses in such cases, are
24	not to be allowed witness fees. A law enforcement officer who has
25	retired or otherwise ceased employment as a law enforcement
26	officer but who is required to testify in any case based on
27	matters that arose during the course of the officer's employment

- 28 shall be entitled to the same compensation and expenses from the
- 29 former employing law enforcement agency as an officer on active
- 30 duty under the same circumstances.
- 31 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after July 1, 2006.
