6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. (1) There is hereby created a task force to
8	conduct a study of long-term prisoners, ways to reduce the costs
9	of incarceration, alternatives to incarceration that ensure the
LO	highest level of public safety in Mississippi and to study the
L1	successful long-term release programs such as Life Line in Canada.
L2	The membership of the task force shall include the following
L3	thirteen (13) members:
L4	(a) The Chairman of the Senate Corrections Committee,
L5	who will serve as temporary chairman of the task force;
L6	(b) One (1) member of the Senate appointed by the
L7	Lieutenant Governor;
L8	(c) The Chairman of the House of Representatives
L9	Corrections Committee;
20	(d) One (1) member of the House appointed by the
21	Speaker of the House;
22	(e) Three (3) members appointed by the Governor;
23	(f) The Commissioner of Corrections;
24	(g) The Chairman of the Parole Board;
25	(h) The State Auditor, or his designee; and
26	(i) The Attorney General, or his designee.
27	(2) The task force shall make a report of its findings and
28	recommendations, including necessary legislation, to the

- 29 Legislature, the Lieutenant Governor and the Governor for
- 30 implementation in the 2007 Regular Session.
- 31 (3) The temporary chairman of the task force shall call a
- 32 meeting within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this bill
- 33 and the task force shall elect a chairman from its membership, in
- 34 addition to such other officers as it may deem appropriate. A
- 35 majority of the members of the committee shall constitute a
- 36 quorum. All members shall be notified in writing of all meetings,
- 37 such notices to be mailed at least five (5) days prior to the date
- 38 on which a meeting is to be held.
- 39 (4) Legislative members of the task force shall be paid from
- 40 the contingent expense funds of their respective houses in the
- 41 same amounts as provided for committee meetings when the
- 42 Legislature is not in session. Nonlegislative members of the task
- 43 force shall be reimbursed for actual necessary expenses in
- 44 attending called meetings of the task force, to be paid from any
- 45 funds made available for such purpose by the Legislature.
- 46 (8) Upon presentation of its final report, the task force
- 47 shall be dissolved.
- 48 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 49 and after its passage.
