## SENATE BILL NO. 2328

1	AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION $45-1-9$ , MISSISSIPPI CODE OF $1972$ ,
2	WHICH PROVIDES THAT EACH HIGHWAY PATROLMAN AND CERTAIN OTHER
3	APPOINTEES SHALL FURNISH A SURETY BOND OF NOT LESS THAN \$2,000.00
4	PAYABLE TO THE STATE AND CONDITIONED UPON THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE
5	OF DUTIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 45-1-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, which
- 8 provides that each highway patrolman and certain other appointees
- 9 shall furnish a surety bond of not less than Two Thousand Dollars
- 10 (\$2,000.00) payable to the state and conditioned upon the faithful
- 11 performance of duties, is hereby repealed.
- 12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 13 and after its passage.
