SENATE BILL NO. 2328

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 45-1-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 WHICH PROVIDES THAT EACH HIGHWAY PATROLMAN AND CERTAIN OTHER
3 APPOINTEES SHALL FURNISH A SURETY BOND OF NOT LESS THAN \$2,000.00
4 PAYABLE TO THE STATE AND CONDITIONED UPON THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE
5 OF DUTIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** Section 45-1-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, which
8 provides that each highway patrolman and certain other appointees
9 shall furnish a surety bond of not less than Two Thousand Dollars
10 (\$2,000.00) payable to the state and conditioned upon the faithful
11 performance of duties, is hereby repealed.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
13 and after its passage.
