## SENATE BILL NO. 2403

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE HIRING OF SPECIAL CONTRACT AGENTS 1 BY THE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; 2 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. (1) The Director of the Bureau of Investigation 5
- is authorized to retain on a contractual basis such persons as he 6
- shall deem necessary to detect and apprehend violators of the 7
- 8 criminal statutes of this state.
- Those persons contracting with the Director of the 9
- Bureau of Investigation, pursuant to subsection (1), shall be 10
- known as, and are hereinafter referred to as, "special contract 11
- 12 agents."
- 13 The investigative services provided for in this section
- shall be designed to support local law enforcement efforts. 14
- 15 Special contract investigators shall have all powers
- necessary and incidental to the fulfillment of their contractual 16
- obligations, including the power of arrest when authorized by the 17

- 19 No person shall be a special contract investigator
- 20 unless he is at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
- 21 The Director of the Bureau of Investigation shall

- 28 of a law relating to meetings open to the public, approved as now
- 29 or hereafter amended.
- 30 (7) Any contract pursuant to subsection (1) shall be:
- 31 (a) Reduced to writing; and
- 32 (b) Terminable upon written notice by either party, and
- 33 shall in any event terminate one (1) year from the date of
- 34 signing; and
- 35 (c) Approved as to form by the Attorney General.
- 36 Such contracts shall not be public records and shall not be
- 37 available for inspection under the provisions of a law providing
- 38 for the inspection of public records as now or hereafter amended.
- 39 (8) Special contract investigators shall not be considered
- 40 employees of the Bureau of Investigation for any purpose.
- 41 (9) The Director of the Bureau of Investigation shall have
