SENATE BILL NO. 2427

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT NO LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD, SCHOOL 1 SUPERINTENDENT OR SCHOOL PRINCIPAL SHALL PROHIBIT A TEACHER FROM 2 DISCUSSING AND ANSWERING QUESTIONS ON THE ISSUE OF FLAWS OR PROBLEMS WHICH MAY EXIST IN DARWIN'S THEORY OF EVOLUTION AND THE EXISTENCE OF OTHER THEORIES OF EVOLUTION, INCLUDING, BUT NOT 3 4 5 б LIMITED TO, THE INTELLIGENT DESIGN EXPLANATION OF THE ORIGIN OF 7 LIFE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. No local school board, school superintendent or 9 10 school principal shall prohibit a public school classroom teacher from discussing and answering questions from individual students 11 on the issue of flaws or problems which may exist in Charles 12 Darwin's Theory of Evolution and the existence of other theories 13 14 of evolution, including, but not limited to, the Intelligent 15 Design explanation of the origin of life. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 16

17 and after its passage.
