## SENATE BILL NO. 2431

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
TO INCORPORATE "RV FRIENDLY" MARKERS ON SERVICE SIGNS FOR
BUSINESSES THAT CATER TO THE NEEDS OF PERSONS DRIVING RECREATIONAL
VEHICLES; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION MAY CHARGE FOR THE ACTUAL COST OF OBTAINING AND
PLACING SUCH MARKERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** (1) (a) Subject to the prior approval of the 9 Federal Highway Administration, the Department of Transportation 10 is directed to incorporate the use of "RV Friendly" markers on specific service signs for business establishments that cater to 11 the needs of persons driving recreational vehicles. 12
- 13 (b) A business establishment that qualifies for participation in the specific service sign program and that also 14 qualifies as "RV Friendly" may request that an "RV Friendly" 15 marker be displayed immediately adjacent to such establishment's 16 17 business logo sign on the appropriate background sign panel.
- 18 The department may charge any business requesting the marker the actual cost of obtaining and placing the marker. 19
- 20 The "RV Friendly" marker to be displayed shall be such marker as may be approved by the Federal Highway 21
- 22 Administration in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The department shall promulgate such rules and 23
- 24 regulations as are necessary to implement the provisions of this
- 25 section, including the promulgation of rules and regulations
- setting forth the minimum requirements that business 26
- 27 establishments must meet in order to qualify as "RV Friendly."
- The requirements shall include, but not be limited to, the 28
- 29 availability at each qualifying business establishment of parking \*SS02/R533\*

- 30 spaces, entrances and exits in sufficient number and of sufficient
- 31 size and dimensions to easily accommodate recreational vehicles,
- 32 and the presence of appropriate overhang clearances at all
- 33 facilities, if applicable.
- 34 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 35 and after July 1, 2006.
