SENATE BILL NO. 2475

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-13-407, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO DELETE CERTAIN PAY-BACK PROVISIONS IN THE TOBACCO SETTLEMENT
- 3 HEALTH CARE TRUST FUND ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 43-13-407, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 43-13-407. (1) In accordance with the purposes of this
- 8 article, there is established in the State Treasury the Health
- 9 Care Expendable Fund, into which shall be transferred from the
- 10 Health Care Trust Fund the following sums:
- 11 (a) In fiscal year 2005, Four Hundred Fifty-six Million
- 12 Dollars (\$456,000,000.00);
- 13 (b) In fiscal year 2006, One Hundred Eighty-six Million
- 14 Dollars (\$186,000,000.00);
- 15 (c) In fiscal year 2007, One Hundred Forty-six Million
- 16 Dollars (\$146,000,000.00);
- 17 (d) In fiscal year 2008, One Hundred Six Million
- 18 Dollars (\$106,000,000.00);
- 19 (e) In fiscal year 2009, Sixty-six Million Dollars
- 20 (\$66,000,000.00);
- 21 (f) In fiscal year 2010 and each fiscal year
- 22 thereafter, a sum equal to the average annual amount of the
- 23 dividends, interest and other income, including increases in value
- 24 of the principal, earned on the funds in the Health Care Trust
- 25 Fund during the preceding four (4) fiscal years.
- 26 (2) In any fiscal year in which interest, dividends and
- 27 other income from the investment of the funds in the Health Care

28 Trust Fund are not sufficient to fund the full amount of the
```

- 29 annual transfer into the Health Care Expendable Fund as required
- 30 in subsection (1)(f) of this section, the State Treasurer shall
- 31 transfer from tobacco settlement installment payments an amount
- 32 that is sufficient to fully fund the amount of the annual
- 33 transfer.
- 34 (3) * * * On March 6, 2002, the State Treasurer shall
- transfer the sum of Eighty-seven Million Dollars (\$87,000,000.00)
- 36 from the Health Care Trust Fund into the Health Care Expendable
- 37 Fund. In addition, at the time the State of Mississippi receives
- 38 the tobacco settlement installment payments for each of the
- 39 calendar years 2002 and 2003, the State Treasurer shall deposit
- 40 the full amount of each of those installment payments into the
- 41 Health Care Expendable Fund.
- 42 * * *
- 43 (4) The total sum of Two Hundred Forty Million Dollars
- 44 (\$240,000,000.00) plus interest at the rate of five percent (5%)
- 45 per annum shall be transferred into the Health Care Trust Fund
- 46 from the State General Fund during fiscal years 2007 through 2013
- 47 to repay the trust fund for Two Hundred Forty Million Dollars
- 48 (\$240,000,000.00) of the total sum that is transferred from the
- 49 trust fund to the Health Care Expendable Fund during fiscal year
- 50 2005 under subsection (1)(a) of this section. The repayment shall
- 51 be made according to the following schedule: During each of
- 52 fiscal years 2007 through 2012, the State Fiscal Officer shall
- 53 transfer from the General Fund to the Health Care Trust Fund the
- 54 sum of Thirty-eight Million Dollars (\$38,000,000.00), and during
- 55 fiscal year 2013 the State Fiscal Officer shall transfer from the
- 56 State General Fund to the Health Care Trust Fund a sum in the
- 57 amount certified by the State Treasurer as necessary to fully
- 58 repay the balance of the Two Hundred Forty Million Dollars
- 59 (\$240,000,000.00) plus interest at the rate of five percent (5%)
- 60 per annum.

- 61 (5) All income from the investment of the funds in the
- 62 Health Care Expendable Fund shall be credited to the account of
- 63 the Health Care Expendable Fund. Any funds in the Health Care
- 64 Expendable Fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into
- 65 the State General Fund.
- 66 (6) The funds in the Health Care Expendable Fund shall be
- 67 available for expenditure under specific appropriation by the
- 68 Legislature beginning in fiscal year 2000, and shall be expended
- 69 exclusively for health care purposes.
- 70 (7) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section may not
- 71 be changed in any manner except upon amendment to that subsection
- 72 by a bill enacted by the Legislature with a vote of not less than
- 73 three-fifths (3/5) of the members of each house present and
- 74 voting.
- 75 (8) Subsections (1), (2), (5) and (6) of this section shall
- 76 stand repealed on July 1, 2009.
- 77 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 78 and after its passage.
