AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-519, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,

2 TO ALLOW MUNICIPALITIES TO OPERATE RADAR WITHIN HIGH SCHOOL, COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND SENIOR COLLEGE SCHOOL ZONES, WHETHER PUBLIC 3 4 OR PRIVATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 63-3-519, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 8 63-3-519. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or peace 9 officer or law enforcement agency, except the Mississippi Highway 10 Safety Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of radar speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or 11 highway of this state. However, such equipment may be used: 12 (a) By municipal law enforcement officers within a 13 municipality having a population of two thousand (2,000) or more 14 upon the public streets of the municipality; 15 16 (b) By any college or university campus police force 17 within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand (2,000) students are enrolled; 18 19 (c) By municipal law enforcement officers in any municipality having a population in excess of fifteen thousand 20 21 (15,000) according to the latest federal census on federally designated highways lying within the corporate limits; 22 23 (d) By municipal law enforcement officers in a municipality of any size population within five hundred (500) feet 24 of the boundary of any public or private secondary school, 25 26 community or junior college, college or university.
