1 2 3 4 5 6	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 23-15-627 AND 23-15-713, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW QUALIFIED ELECTORS TO VOTE BY ABSENTEE BALLOT FOR ANY REASON; TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-653, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE ALL REGISTRARS' OFFICES TO REMAIN OPEN FROM 7 A.M. TO 7 P.M. ON THE THREE SATURDAYS PRIOR TO EACH ELECTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. Section 23-15-627, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9	amended as follows:
10	23-15-627. The registrar shall be responsible for furnishing
11	an absentee ballot application form to any elector authorized to
12	receive an absentee ballot. Absentee ballot applications shall be
13	furnished to a person only upon the oral or written request of the
14	elector who seeks to vote by absentee ballot; however, the parent,
15	child, spouse, sibling, legal guardian, those empowered with a
16	power of attorney for that elector's affairs or agent of the
17	elector may orally request an absentee ballot application on
18	behalf of the elector. An absentee ballot application must have
19	the seal of the circuit or municipal clerk affixed to it and be
20	initialed by the registrar or his deputy in order to be utilized
21	to obtain an absentee ballot. A reproduction of an absentee
22	ballot application shall not be valid unless it is a reproduction
23	provided by the office of the registrar of the jurisdiction in
24	which the election is being held and which contains the seal and
25	initials required by this section. Such application shall be
26	substantially in the following form:

L14	SECTION 2. Section 23-15-713, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
L15	amended as follows:
L16	23-15-713. For the purpose of this subarticle, any duly
L17	qualified elector may vote as provided in this subarticle if he be
L18	one who falls within the following categories:
L19	(a) Any qualified elector who is a bona fide student,
L20	teacher or administrator at any college, university, junior
L21	college, high, junior high, or elementary grade school whose
L22	studies or employment at such institution necessitates his absence
L23	from the county of his voting residence on the date of any
L24	primary, general or special election, or the spouse and dependents
L25	of said student, teacher or administrator if such spouse or
L26	dependent(s) maintain a common domicile, outside of the county of
L27	his voting residence, with such student, teacher or administrator.

- (b) Any qualified elector who is required to be away
- 129 from his place of residence on any election day due to his
- 130 employment as an employee of a member of the Mississippi

- 144 distant from his residence, if the parent, spouse or dependent

- 146 (f) Any person who is sixty-five (65) years of age or

- 148 (g) Any member of the Mississippi congressional
- 149 delegation absent from Mississippi on election day, and the spouse
- 150 and dependents of such member of the congressional delegation.

- 152 **SECTION 3.** Section 23-15-653, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 153 amended as follows:
- 154 23-15-653. All registrars' offices shall remain open from
- 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on the three (3) Saturdays prior to each
- 156 election.
- 157 **SECTION 4.** The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 158 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 159 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 160 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States

- 161 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 162 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 163 extended.
- 164 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 165 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 166 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
