## SENATE BILL NO. 2515

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND 1 2 ADMINISTRATION TO INITIATE A FACILITY AUDIT OF STATE-OWNED 3 FACILITIES; TO REQUIRE THE BUREAU OF BUILDING, GROUNDS AND REAL 4 PROPERTY MANAGEMENT TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO THE AUDIT DATA TO THE LEGISLATURE AND OTHER STATE AGENCIES THAT ARE AFFECTED; TO DIRECT 5 б THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO ONLY USE 7 DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO INITIATE THE FACILITY AUDIT; AND FOR 8 RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Department of Finance and 10 11 Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management, is hereby authorized and directed to 12 initiate a facility audit for state-owned structures managed by 13 14 the Department of Finance and Administration and report on or before January 1, 2007, to the Joint Facilities Management 15 Advisory Committee. The report shall also include a plan to audit 16 all state-owned facilities, in addition to the structures managed 17 18 by the Department of Finance and Administration, on or before January 1, 2009. The facility audit shall be performed by a 19 20 professional architectural/engineering entity and maintained through completion. 21 (2) The facility audit shall encompass all existing 2.2 23 state-owned facilities and further incorporate all new constructed state-owned facilities managed by the Department of Finance and 24 25 Administration. The facility audit reporting shall be administered at the discretion of the Bureau of Building, Grounds 26 27 and Real Property Management for the purpose of generating 28 reports, determining the value of state-owned facilities and their size, scale, composition, condition and location, and qualifying 29 30 and prioritizing capital improvement, repair and renovation \*SS03/R93\* S. 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31 requests. The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 32 Management shall provide access to the facility audit data to the 33 Legislature and other state agencies that are affected and from 34 which the data is compiled. The Department of Finance and 35 Administration through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real 36 Property Management, is directed to only use discretionary funds 37 to initiate the facility audit.

38 (3) It is the intent of the Legislature to authorize the 39 facility audit to establish the consolidation of data into a 40 centralized location, to heighten efficiency in processing capital 41 improvement and repair and renovation projects, and to possess the 42 ability to produce data queries on any given entry.

43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from44 and after its passage.
