- 9 court who shall attempt, by guile or force or violence to any
- 10 person, to escape, whether the escape be effected or not, shall,
- 11 upon conviction, be found guilty of a misdemeanor and sentenced to
- 12 imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months.
- 13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 14 and after July 1, 2006.
