SENATE BILL NO. 2656

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 29-5-81, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO ENFORCE
3 LAWS ON THE GROUNDS OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL OFFICE
4 LOCATED IN THE CITY OF GLUCKSTADT, MISSISSIPPI, AND THE STATE TAX
5 COMMISSION MAIN OFFICE BUILDING LOCATED IN THE CITY OF CLINTON,
6 MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** Section 29-5-81, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9 amended as follows:

10 29-5-81. Grounds of public buildings over which the
11 Department of Finance and Administration has jurisdiction shall
12 comprise the following:

13 (a) In the City of Jackson, Mississippi:

14 New State Capitol: Bounded on the north by High Street, on
15 the west by North West Street, on the south by Mississippi Street,
16 and on the east by North President Street;

17 Governor's Mansion: Bounded on the north by Amite Street, on
18 the west by North West Street, on the south by Capitol Street and
19 on the east by North Congress Street;

20 Woolfolk State Office Building: Bounded on the north by High
21 Street, on the west by Lamar Street, on the south by Hamilton
22 Street and on the east by North West Street;

23 Old State Capitol and War Veterans' Memorial Building
24 Complex: Bounded on the north by Amite Street, on the west by
25 North State Street and South State Street, on the south by Pearl
26 Street and on the east by property of the Gulf, Mobile and Ohio
27 Railroad Company;

28 Carroll Gartin Justice Building and Walter Sillers Office
29 Building Complex: Bounded on the north by George Street, on the

30 west by North West Street, on the south by High Street and on the
31 east by North President Street;

32 Heber Ladner Building: Bounded on the north by Mississippi
33 Street, on the west by North Congress Street, on the south by the
34 property of Galloway Methodist Church used as a parking lot and on
35 the east by the property on which the Mississippi Farm Bureau
36 Federation Building stands;

37 State Board of Health Building: Bounded on the north by
38 Stadium Drive, on the west by the property of Mississippi Hospital
39 and Medical Service, on the southwest by property on which is
40 located a Standard Oil service station, on the southeast by
41 property leased by the Mississippi Federation of Women's Clubs and
42 on the east by North State Street;

43 Robert E. Lee Building and other properties acquired in the
44 same transaction: Particularly described in warranty deed
45 executed and delivered on April 22, 1969, and filed for record in
46 the Office of the Chancery Clerk of the First Judicial District of
47 Hinds County, Mississippi, located in Jackson, Mississippi, on
48 April 25, 1969, at 9:00 a.m., and recorded in Deed Book No. 1822,
49 page 136 et seq.;

50 Charlotte Capers Building: Bounded on the north by the Old
51 Capitol Building, on the west by South State Street, on the south
52 by Pearl Street, and on the east by the Illinois Central Railroad
53 tracks;

54 William F. Winter Archives and History Building: Bounded on
55 the north by Mississippi Street, on the west by North Street, on
56 the south by Amite Street, and on the east by Jefferson Street;

57 Mayfair Building: Bounded on the north by George Street, on
58 the west by Northwest Street, on the south by Walter Sillers
59 Office Building complex, and on the east by North President
60 Street;

61 Court of Appeals Building: Bounded on the west by North
62 State Street, on the north by George Street, on the east by North

63 Street, and on the south by the building designated as 654 North
64 State Street, including the parking area east of and adjacent to
65 the 654 North State Street Building;

66 Central High Building;

67 101 Capitol Centre: Located at 101 West Capitol Street,
68 Jackson, Mississippi;

69 Robert G. Clark, Jr. Building: Located at 301 North Lamar
70 Street, Jackson, Mississippi.

71 (b) The Dr. Eldon Langston Bolton Building: Located in
72 the City of Biloxi, Mississippi.

73 (c) The State Service Center: Located at the
74 intersection of U.S. Highway 49 and John Merl Tatum Industrial
75 Drive in the City of Hattiesburg, Mississippi.

76 (d) The Alcoholic Beverage Control Office, State Tax
77 Commission: Located in the City of Gluckstadt, Mississippi;

78 (e) The State Tax Commission Main Office Building:
79 Located at 1577 Springridge Road, in the City of Clinton,
80 Mississippi;

81 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
82 and after its passage.
