- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The lyrics and music in the song entitled
- 7 "Miss the Mississippi and You" by Jimmy Rodgers (the Father of
- 8 Country Music) is hereby designated as the official Country Music
- 9 Song of the State of Mississippi.
- 10 (2) The lyrics and music in the song entitled "Crossroads"
- 11 by early bluesman Robert Johnson (who sold his soul to the devil
- 12 to play the Blues) is hereby designated as the official Blues Song
- 13 of the State of Mississippi.
- 14 (3) The Division of Tourism of the Mississippi Development
- 15 Authority, all other agencies of the state and all persons, firms
- 16 or organizations interested in promoting the welfare of the State
- 17 of Mississippi are specifically authorized and empowered to make
- 18 use of the official Country Music Song and the official Blues Song
- 19 in promoting and advancing the State of Mississippi and its
- 20 citizens.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2006.
