7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. Section 59-21-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9	amended as follows:
10	59-21-25. (1) Fees for the award of certificates of number
11	for original, transfer, renewal, livery, dealer and duplicate
12	shall be as follows:
13	<u>(a) Less than 16 feet</u>
14	(b) 16 feet but less than 26 feet \$ 22.50
15	(c) 26 feet but less than 40 feet
16	<u>(d) 40 feet and over</u>
17	(e) <i>Dealer number</i>
18	<u>(f) <i>Duplicate</i></u>
19	(g) Boat inspection fee \$ 10.00
20	(2) All fees for numbers and renewal of number shall be
21	payable to the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and
22	Parks to be deposited by the department in the State Treasury in a
23	special fund to be designated as the Fisheries and Wildlife Fund,
24	which shall be disbursed upon the recommendation of the department
25	as may be appropriated by the Legislature. The State Treasurer
26	shall release to the department such sums as are required to
27	defray all administrative costs of the boat registration fee

- 35 and above the actual administrative cost of implementing this act

- 38 **SECTION 2.** Section 59-21-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 39 amended as follows:
- 40 59-21-19. (1) The certificate of number shall be
- 41 pocket-size, approximately two and one-half inches (2-1/2") by
- 42 three and one-half inches (3-1/2"), and water resistant.
- 43 (2) Pending the issuance of the original certificate of
- 44 number, the owner of the vessel may be furnished a temporary
- 45 certificate of number valid for sixty (60) days from the date of
- 46 issue. This temporary certificate shall be carried on board when
- 47 the vessel is being operated.
- 48 (3) Each applicant for an original or transfer certificate
- 49 of number, who is entitled to issuance thereof, shall be issued a
- 50 certificate for a period of three (3) years from the last day of
- 51 the month of receipt of the original or transfer certificate.
- 52 This subsection shall not apply to the certificate of number of a
- 53 livery boat.
- 54 (4) The certificate of number of a livery boat shall be
- 55 plainly marked "livery boat." The description of the motor and
- 56 type of fuel will be omitted from the certificate of number in any
- 57 case where the motor is not rented with the boat. Original and
- 58 renewal certificates of number of a livery boat shall be valid for
- 59 a period of three (3) years and shall expire at midnight on
- 60 June 30 * * *.

62 operated by manufacturers and dealers may be transferred from one

- 63 (1) boat to another. In lieu of the description, the word
- 64 "manufacturer" or "dealer," as appropriate, will be plainly marked
- on each certificate. The manufacturer or dealer may have the
- 66 number awarded printed upon or attached to a removable sign or
- 67 signs to be temporarily mounted upon or attached to the boat being
- 68 demonstrated or tested so long as the display meets the
- 69 requirements of Section 59-21-9.
- 70 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 71 and after July 1, 2006.
