## SENATE BILL NO. 2693

AN ACT TO CREATE A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE 1 2 DEPOSIT OF FEDERAL FUNDS ALLOCATED TO MISSISSIPPI UNDER THE DEFICIT REDUCTION ACT OF 2005 (S. 1932) FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING THE STATE'S SHARE UNDER THE MEDICAID PROGRAM DUE TO THE 3 4 HURRICANE KATRINA DISASTER; TO PROVIDE THAT THESE FUNDS SHALL BE 5 б APPROPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING THE 7 STATE MATCH REQUIREMENTS FOR KATRINA DISASTER RELIEF PROGRAMS 8 PROVIDED BY FEMA UNDER THE STAFFORD ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 10 SECTION 1. (1) There is hereby created in the State 11 Treasury a special fund to be designated the Hurricane Katrina Federal Medicaid State Share Replacement Fund. The State 12 Treasurer shall deposit the following funds into said fund: All 13 14 federal funds allocated to the State of Mississippi for the fiscal relief of the state's Medicaid program under The Deficit Reduction 15 Act of 2005 (S. 1932) for the following allowable expenses: 16 (a) For the state share of Medicaid services from 17 August 24, 2005, through June 30, 2006, for evacuees from other 18 19 states and for individuals that resided in one (1) of the lower forty-seven (47) counties of Mississippi receiving benefits under 20 21 an approved multi-state 1115 demonstration project (Katrina Waiver); 2.2 23 (b) For the total uncompensated care costs incurred for medically necessary services from August 24, 2005, through January 24 31, 2006, for evacuees from other states and for individuals that 25 resided in one (1) of the lower forty-seven (47) counties of 26 Mississippi who do not have other coverage for such assistance 27 28 through insurance, including, but not limited to, private

- 29 insurance, Medicaid or SCHIP, or state-funded health insurance
- 30 programs;

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(c) For the state share until June 30, 2006, of 31 32 services for individuals that reside in one (1) of the lower 33 forty-seven (47) counties of Mississippi who are eligible for benefits under the regular Medicaid or SCHIP program; and 34

35 (d)For costs associated with restoring access to 36 health care in the impacted Hurricane Katrina disaster counties as per the approval of the Secretary of the United States Department 37 of Health and Human Services. 38

The Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of 39 (2)Finance and Administration, pursuant to specific appropriation 40 41 therefor by the Legislature, is hereby directed to transfer any funds in the Hurricane Katrina Federal Medicaid State Share 42 43 Replacement Fund to the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency 44 (MEMA) or other appropriate fund for the purpose of providing state matching requirements for the State of Mississippi for 45 services provided by FEMA to fund Stafford Act activities directly 46 47 related to the Hurricane Katrina disaster in Mississippi as required by federal law. These activities include, but are not 48 limited to, debris removal, rebuilding highways, rebuilding 49 50 schools and rebuilding other public buildings.

(3) Any funds remaining in the Hurricane Katrina Federal 51 52 Medicaid State Share Replacement Fund at the end of any fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund but shall remain 53 in said special fund. Any interest earned on the Hurricane 54 55 Katrina Federal Medicaid State Share Replacement Fund shall be applied to, and shall remain in said special fund. 56

57 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 58 and after its passage.

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
