- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 49-7-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 49-7-47. (1) The commission may control, regulate and 7
- 8 manage the taking of all alligators * * *.
- (2) Residents and nonresidents shall be required to purchase 9
- a combination hunting and fishing license to hunt, kill or catch 10
- any alligator * * * for sporting purposes. 11
- 12 (3) Residents and nonresidents shall be required to obtain a
- 13 special permit to hunt, kill, catch or possess any alligator * * *
- for commercial purposes. The commission may establish a 14
- 15 reasonable fee for an annual special sporting permit, not to
- exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), and may prescribe 16
- regulations governing commercial trade in alligators * * *. Any 17
- 18 reasonable fee established for an annual special commercial permit
- shall not exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). Such permit 19
- 20 shall be good from the date of its issuance to June 30 following
- 21 its date.
- 22 (4) Any person violating this section is guilty, upon
- 23 conviction, of a Class I offense and is punishable as provided in
- Section 49-7-141. 24
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 25
- 26 and after July 1, 2006.
