- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 49-7-51, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 7 49-7-51. (1) It is unlawful for any person to buy or sell
- 8 or to offer for sale, exchange for merchandise, or other
- 9 consideration, within this state, any game birds, game animals, or
- game fish, or parts thereof, named in this chapter, whether taken 10
- within or coming from without the state, except as specifically 11
- 12 permitted by law or regulation. However, the skins and sinew of
- 13 deer and products crafted, fashioned or made from deer antlers not
- in velvet may be bought and sold at any time in accordance with 14
- 15 rules and regulations promulgated by the Commission on Wildlife,
- Fisheries and Parks. Mounted game animals, birds and fish may not 16
- be sold or purchased. A violation of this subsection is a Class I 17
- 18 violation and is punishable as provided in Section 49-7-141.
- Any person who buys, sells, offers for sale, exchange 19
- 20 for merchandise, or other consideration, any wild bird, wild
- 21 animal or fish that has been taken illegally is guilty of a Class
- I violation and punished as provided in Section 49-7-141. 22
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23
- and after July 1, 2006. 24
