SENATE BILL NO. 2777

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 97-29-49, 97-29-51 AND 97-29-53,
MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT PROSTITUTION AND
SOLICITATION OF PROSTITUTION, INCLUDING SOLICITATION BY SUPPLYING
DRUGS, SHALL BE A FELONY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 97-29-49, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

97-29-49. It shall be unlawful to engage in prostitution or 8 9 to aid or abet prostitution or to procure or solicit by any means 10 for the purposes of prostitution, or to reside in, enter, or remain in any place, structure, or building, or to enter or remain 11 12 in any vehicle or conveyance for the purpose of lewdness, assignation, or prostitution, or to keep or set up a house of 13 ill-fame, brothel or bawdy house, or to receive any person for 14 purposes of lewdness, assignation, or prostitution into any 15 16 vehicle, conveyance, place, structure or building, or to permit 17 any person to remain for the purpose of lewdness, assignation, or prostitution in any vehicle, conveyance, place, structure, or 18 19 building, or to direct, take, or transport, or to offer or agree to take or transport, or aid or assist in transporting, any person 20 21 to any vehicle, conveyance, place, structure, or building, or to any other person with knowledge or reasonable cause to know that 22 23 the purpose of such directing, taking or transporting is 24 prostitution, lewdness or assignation, or to lease or rent or contract to lease or rent any vehicle, conveyance, place, 25 26 structure, or building, or part thereof, knowing or with good reason to know that it is intended to be used for any of the 27

28 purposes herein prohibited, or to aid, abet, or participate in the 29 doing of any of the acts herein prohibited.

31 SECTION 2. Section 97-29-51, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 32 amended as follows:

97-29-51. It shall further be unlawful to procure a female 33 inmate for a house of prostitution, or to cause, induce, persuade, 34 or encourage by promise, threat, violence, offer of controlled 35 substances, or by scheme or device, a female to become a 36 37 prostitute or to remain an inmate of a house of prostitution, or 38 to induce, persuade, or encourage a female to come into or leave this state for the purpose of prostitution, or to become an inmate 39 40 in a house of prostitution, or to receive or give, or agree to receive or give any money or thing of value for procuring, or 41 attempting to procure any female to become a prostitute or an 42 inmate in a house of prostitution, or to knowingly accept, 43 44 receive, levy or appropriate any money or other thing of value 45 without consideration from a prostitute or from the proceeds of 46 any woman engaged in prostitution.

47 SECTION 3. Section 97-29-53, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
48 amended as follows:

49 97-29-53. Any person, partnership, association or corporation 50 violating any provision of <u>Section</u> 97-29-49 or 97-29-51 shall, upon 51 conviction, be <u>guilty of a felony and</u> punished by a fine not exceeding 52 <u>Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00)</u> or by confinement in the <u>custody of</u> 53 <u>the Department of Corrections</u> for not more than <u>two (2) years</u>, or by 54 both such fine and imprisonment.

55 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 56 and after July 1, 2006.
