11	other biological and ecological data to determine management
12	measures necessary for their continued ability to sustain
13	themselves successfully. On the basis of such determinations the
14	commission shall issue proposed regulations * * * and develop
15	management programs, designed to insure the continued ability of
16	nongame wildlife to perpetuate themselves successfully. Such
17	proposed regulations shall set forth species or subspecies of
18	nongame wildlife which the commission deems in need of management
19	pursuant to this section, giving their common and scientific names
20	by species and subspecies. The commission shall conduct ongoing
21	investigations of nongame wildlife and may from time to time amend
