SENATE BILL NO. 2819

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-29-146, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO CREATE A FELONY OFFENSE OF SALE, MANUFACTURE, DISTRIBUTION OR 3 POSSESSION OF A SUBSTANCE MISREPRESENTED AS A CONTROLLED 4 SUBSTANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6 SECTION 1. Section 41-29-146, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7 amended as follows:

8 41-29-146. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, 9 produce, manufacture or possess with the intent to sell, produce, 10 manufacture, distribute or dispense any substance which is falsely 11 represented to be a controlled substance or which is *** * *** a 12 counterfeit substance as defined in Section 41-29-105.

(2) The provisions of this section shall not apply to a law
enforcement officer acting in the course and scope of his
employment or to a medical practitioner, pharmacist or other
person authorized to dispense or administer controlled substances.

17 (3) Any person who violates this section shall, upon 18 conviction, be guilty of a <u>felony</u> and may be punished by 19 <u>confinement</u> in the <u>custody of the Department of Corrections</u> for 20 not more than <u>five (5) years</u> or by a fine of not more than <u>Five</u> 21 <u>Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00)</u> or *** * *** both.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
