- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-3-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 97-3-101. (1) Every person who shall be convicted of sexual
- 8 battery under Section 97-3-95(1)(a), (b), or (2) shall be
- 9 imprisoned in the State Penitentiary for a period of not less than
- 10 five (5) nor more than thirty (30) years, and for a second or
- 11 subsequent such offense shall be imprisoned in the penitentiary
- 12 for not less than ten (10) nor more than forty (40) years.
- 13 (2) (a) Every person who shall be convicted of sexual
- 14 battery under Section 97-3-95(1)(c) who is at least eighteen (18)
- 15 but under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be imprisoned for not
- 16 more than five (5) years in the State Penitentiary or fined not
- more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or both;
- 18 (b) Every person who shall be convicted of sexual
- 19 battery under Section 97-3-95(1)(c) who is twenty-one (21) years
- 20 of age or older shall be imprisoned not more than thirty (30)
- 21 years in the State Penitentiary or fined not more than Ten
- 22 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or both, for the first offense, and
- 23 not more than forty (40) years in the State Penitentiary for each
