SENATE BILL NO. 2898

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-21-63, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO INCREASE THE FEE FOR CERTAIN APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATE OF
3 TITLE AND APPLICATION FOR A REPLACEMENT OR CORRECTED CERTIFICATE
4 OF TITLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-21-63, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7 amended as follows:

8 63-21-63. There shall be paid to the State Tax Commission
9 for issuing and processing documents required by this chapter,
10 fees for motor vehicles according to the following schedule:

- 11 (a) Each application for certificate of title issued
12 under Section 63-21-9(2)..... \$ 8.00;
- 13 (b) Each application for certificate of title not
14 issued under Section 63-21-9(2)..... 9.00;
- 15 (c) Each application for replacement or
16 corrected certificate of title..... 9.00;
- 17 (d) Each suspension or revocation of
18 certificate of title..... 4.00;
- 19 (e) Each notice of security interest..... 4.00;
- 20 (f) Each release of security interest..... 4.00;
- 21 (g) Each assignment by lienholder..... 4.00;
- 22 (h) Each application for information as to
23 the status of the title of a vehicle..... 4.00.

24 The designated agent may add the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to
25 each document processed for which a fee is charged to be retained
26 as his commission for services rendered. All other fees collected
27 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission.

28 If more than one (1) transaction be involved in any
29 application on a single vehicle and if supported by all required
30 documents, the fee charged by the State Tax Commission and by the
31 designated agent for processing and issuing shall be considered as
32 only one (1) transaction.

33 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
34 and after July 1, 2006.
