COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2924

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 55-23-8, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
 ALLOW EXISTING LEASES ON ALL OR ANY PART OF THE MISSISSIPPI
 VETERANS MEMORIAL STADIUM PROPERTY TO BE CONVERTED, AT THE OPTION OF THE LESSEE, TO 50-YEAR LEASES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
 SECTION 1. Section 55-23-8, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 amended as follows:

8 55-23-8. (1) The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium 9 Commission, in its discretion, is authorized to enter into one or more lease agreements with one or more public or private entities 10 in regard to the granting of a property interest to such public or 11 private entities in all or any part of the real property located 12 in Hinds County, Mississippi, generally known as the "Mississippi 13 Veterans Memorial Stadium Property, " being any property under the 14 jurisdiction of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium 15 16 Commission and any other state-owned property located in the area bounded on the North by Taylor Street, on the West by North West 17 Street, on the South by Woodrow Wilson Avenue and on the East by 18 19 North State Street used as part of or in connection with Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium, for the purpose of the 20 21 construction of improvements thereon. (2) Any lease authorized in this section may be for such 22 23 consideration as determined appropriate by the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission and may be for a primary term 24

25 not to exceed twenty-five (25) years and may be renewed for a term

26 not to exceed twenty-five (25) years. <u>However, any lease</u>

29 <u>be converted, at the option of the lessee, to a fifty-year term</u>
30 <u>lease beginning on the date of the original lease and may not be</u>
31 <u>renewed after the end of the lease. The commission may prepare</u>
32 <u>and execute any documents and take any actions necessary to carry</u>
33 out such purposes.

34 In and for the consideration to be provided under any (3) 35 lease, the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, in its discretion, is authorized to, on such terms and conditions 36 determined to be appropriate by the Mississippi Veterans Memorial 37 38 Stadium Commission: (a) enter into agreements with any such 39 lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees), which agreements may extend over any period of time not exceeding 40 41 the term of such lease (including renewals and extensions) 42 permitting use of any property referred to in subsection (1) of this section for parking, access and other uses in connection with 43 events in facilities constructed on property leased from the 44 45 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission; (b) grant, as 46 part of and for the term of any lease, to any lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees), one or more 47 48 easements with respect to all or any part of the property referred to in subsection (1) of this section for vehicle and pedestrian 49 50 ingress and egress, for vehicle parking and for such other purposes necessary and appropriate for the construction, operation 51 and use of the improvements; (c) enter into agreements with any 52 53 such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or 54 lessees), which agreements may extend over any period of time not 55 exceeding the term of such lease (including renewals and 56 extensions), permitting use by such lessee or lessees (or any 57 designee of any such lessee or lessees) of Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium for events; (d) enter into agreements with any 58 59 such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or 60 lessees), which agreements may extend over any period of time not exceeding the term of such lease (including renewals and 61 \*SS02/R1169CS\* S. 62 extensions), pursuant to which the state shall be obligated to 63 purchase improvements constructed on such property and/or any 64 residual rights in connection with such improvements upon terms 65 and for a purchase price, not to exceed Ten Million Dollars 66 (\$10,000,000.00), as set forth in or determined in accordance with 67 such agreement; (e) enter into agreements with any such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees) providing 68 that such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or 69 70 lessees) shall indemnify and hold harmless the Mississippi 71 Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission for any personal injury or 72 property damage related to events conducted on property leased from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission; and/or 73 74 (f) enter into such other agreements with any such lessee or 75 lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees) or any 76 other public or private entities, which agreements may extend over 77 any period of time not exceeding the term of such lease (including 78 renewals and extensions), relating to any such lease and any 79 improvements to be constructed on property leased from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission as the 80 81 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission shall determine 82 to be appropriate. However, the State of Mississippi shall not be 83 obligated to purchase any improvements constructed on property leased under this section and/or any residual rights in connection 84 with such improvements unless the construction of all such 85 86 improvements on the property is complete. The Department of 87 Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, 88 Grounds and Real Property Management shall make the determination 89 regarding whether the construction of the improvements is 90 complete.

91 (4) Any public body shall be authorized to enter into: (a) 92 agreements (which may extend over any period of time) with the 93 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, any public body, 94 any party leasing property from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial S. 95 Stadium Commission (or any designee or designees of any such 96 lessee), and/or any other party to provide or contribute funds in 97 connection with the construction, financing and/or operation of 98 any improvements constructed on property leased from the 99 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, and any such 100 agreement or agreements and the obligations of any public body 101 thereunder shall not be included in computing amounts subject to 102 any debt limitations applicable to any such public body; and/or 103 (b) agreements (which may extend over any period of time) to lease 104 property from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission 105 and to provide or contribute funds in connection with the 106 construction, financing and/or operation of any improvements 107 constructed on such property and to lease or sublease any such 108 property or improvements to public or private entities, and any such agreement or agreements shall not be included in computing 109 amounts subject to any debt limitations applicable to any such 110 111 public body.

(5) The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, in its discretion, is authorized to enter into all other agreements as may be necessary or appropriate in connection with any financing by any lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees) of any improvements to be constructed on property leased from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission.

(6) The provisions of any statutes establishing a role for the Department of Finance and Administration and the State Bond Commission in financing, construction and improvement of buildings on the Veterans Memorial Stadium property shall not apply to the financing, refinancing, construction, repair or improvement of any improvements on any property leased pursuant to this section.

125 (7) Before entering into any lease or other agreement with 126 any private entity under this section, the Mississippi Veterans 127 Memorial Stadium Commission shall require such entity to enter S. B. No. 2924 \*SS02/R1169CS\* 06/SS02/R1169CS

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into a binding commitment providing that if the private entity 128 129 fails to complete the construction of all improvements commenced 130 by the entity on property leased under this section, such entity 131 shall reimburse the State of Mississippi for costs incurred by the 132 state relating to the improvements. The Department of Finance and 133 Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management shall make the determination regarding 134 whether the construction of the improvements is complete. 135

136 (8) Any lease or other agreement entered into by the 137 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission under this 138 section shall not be valid unless approved by the Department of 139 Finance and Administration, the Public Procurement Review Board 140 and the Attorney General.

141 (9) <u>Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2)</u>, the 142 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission may not enter 143 into any lease or other agreement under this section after October 144 1, 2001.

(10) Any lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees) of property leased from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission under this section shall not be considered as being the state, any political subdivision of the state or any officer or servant of the state for the purposes of any liability that may be waived under Section 11-46-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

152 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 153 and after July 1, 2006, and shall repeal on June 30, 2006.
