SENATE BILL NO. 2936

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 39-5-91, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 CHANGE THE NAME OF THE MISSISSIPPI CIVIL WAR BATTLEFIELD 3 COMMISSION TO THE MISSISSIPPI CIVIL WAR SITES COMMISSION; TO 4 PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR THEIR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY TRAVELING EXPENSES INCURRED IN 5 б ATTENDING THE QUARTERLY MEETINGS OF THE COMMISSION; TO PROVIDE 7 THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY SHALL BE THE FISCAL 8 AGENT FOR THE COMMISSION REGARDING REQUISITIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT 9 OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION; TO PROVIDE THAT THE COMMISSION 10 SHALL DESIGN AND ERECT CIVIL WAR SITES HISTORICAL MARKERS AT 11 VARIOUS CIVIL WAR SITES THROUGHOUT THE STATE; TO PRESCRIBE THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION REGARDING CIVIL WAR SITES 12 HISTORICAL MARKERS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE COMMISSION MAY SOLICIT AND RECEIVE FROM ANY SOURCE MONEY, MATERIALS AND PROPERTY OF ANY KIND; 13 14 TO PROVIDE THAT ALL FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE COMMISSION SHALL BE 15 16 DEPOSITED INTO A SPECIAL FUND THAT IS CREATED IN THE STATE 17 TREASURY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 39-5-91, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

39-5-91. (1) There is * * * created a Mississippi Civil War 21 Sites Commission consisting of the following fifteen (15) members: 22 23 (a) Nine (9) members appointed by the Governor with three (3) serving for an initial term concluding on March 1, 1998, 24 25 three (3) serving for an initial term concluding on March 1, 2000, and three (3) serving for an initial term concluding on March 1, 26 27 2002; 28 (b) One (1) member appointed by the Lieutenant Governor for an initial term concluding on March 1, 2002; 29 30 (c) One (1) member appointed by the Speaker of the Mississippi House of Representatives for an initial term 31 concluding on March 1, 2002; 32 33 (d) One (1) member appointed by the Jackson Civil War 34 Roundtable for an initial term concluding on March 1, 2002; and *SS01/R1174* S. B. No. 2936 G1/2 35 (e) Three (3) members appointed by the Board of
36 Trustees of the Department of Archives and History for an initial
37 term concluding on March 1, 2002.

After the initial terms, all terms shall be for six (6) years. An appointment to fill a vacancy which arises for reasons other than by expiration of a term of office shall be made by the respective appointing authority for the unexpired term only.

42 (2) The commission shall elect from its membership a
43 chairman who shall preside over meetings and a vice chairman who
44 shall preside in the absence of the chairman or when the chairman
45 is excused.

(3) The commission shall adopt rules and regulations 46 47 governing times and places for meetings. A majority of members of the commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of 48 49 any business. The commission shall meet at least quarterly. The 50 commission may form subcommittees to address specific issues concerning preservation and enhancement of Civil War sites and 51 52 structures. The commission may adopt other procedures necessary to ensure the orderly transaction of business. 53

54 (4) The members of the commission shall receive no
55 compensation for their services. <u>However, the members of the</u>
56 <u>commission shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary</u>
57 <u>traveling expenses incurred in attending the quarterly meetings of</u>
58 <u>the commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section</u>

Principal staff support for the commission shall be 60 (5) 61 provided by the Department of Archives and History. Other agencies shall assist when requested by the commission. 62 The Department of Archives and History shall be the fiscal agent for 63 64 the commission in processing and submitting requisitions on behalf 65 of the commission for the issuance of warrants by the Department 66 of Finance and Administration, and shall use information provided 67 by the commission to prepare the requisitions. *SS01/R1174* S. B. No. 2936

The commission shall have the following duties: 68 (6) 69 (a) Identify and prioritize for protecting 70 Mississippi's Civil War sites and structures; 71 (b) Identify, analyze and enhance preservation 72 opportunities for Mississippi's Civil War sites and structures; 73 Review existing local, state and federal plans, (C) programs and policies related to Mississippi's Civil War sites and 74 75 structures; 76 (d) Develop relationships with federal and local 77 officials and private conservation organizations that facilitate 78 protection and enhancement of Civil War sites and structures; 79 (e) Coordinate Mississippi's participation with the 80 federal government and private foundations to secure support and financial resources for the protection and enhancement of Civil 81 War sites and structures; 82 83 (f) Advise state agencies on matters relating to Civil 84 War sites and structures; and 85 Perform any other such duties or actions in an (g) effort to advance Civil War history in Mississippi. 86 87 (7) In addition to the duties specified under subsection (6) of this section, the commission shall design and erect Civil War 88 89 sites historical markers at various Civil War sites throughout the 90 state. The commission may require matching funds from local communities in order to locate Civil War sites historical markers 91 92 in the communities. The duties of the commission regarding Civil War sites historical markers shall be as follows: 93 94 (a) Designing the Civil War sites historical markers, which shall be in a style to be determined by the commission and 95 distinctive from the state historical markers used by the 96 97 Department of Archives and History; (b) Identifying sites in the state that are eligible 98 99 for Civil War sites historical markers;

No. 2936 *SSO1/R1174* 06/SS01/R1174 PAGE 3 100 (c) Consulting with state and local officials on the sites selected for Civil War sites historical markers; 101 102 (d) Reviewing existing state historical markers related 103 to the Civil War and making recommendations to the Department of 104 Archives and History on those needing replacement and/or repair; 105 (e) Preparing appropriate content and drafting 106 appropriate text for Civil War sites historical markers, and 107 working with staff of the Department of Archives and History to 108 edit, order and erect the markers, in cooperation with the Mississippi Department of Transportation district offices; and 109 110 (f) Planning and participating in, in cooperation with 111 state and local officials and other interested organizations, 112 appropriate dedication ceremonies for Civil War sites historical markers and other events related to Civil War history, including 113 the Civil War Sesquicentennial. 114 (8) The commission may solicit and receive from any source, 115 whether federal, state, public or private, grants, donations, 116 117 contributions, gifts, devises and bequests of money, materials and property of any kind. 118 119 (9) All funds received by the commission shall be deposited 120 into a special fund that is created in the State Treasury, to be 121 known as the Mississippi Civil War Sites Commission Fund. Monies 122 in the special fund shall be expended only for the purposes authorized for the commission, upon appropriation by the 123 124 Legislature. Unexpended amounts remaining in the special fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General 125 126 Fund, and any interest earned on amounts in the special fund shall be deposited to the credit of the special fund. 127 (10) The commission shall submit to the Governor an annual 128 129 report by December 1 of each year which shall include recommendations for any legislative, administrative or other 130 131 changes the commission deems necessary to further Civil War 132 history in Mississippi. *SS01/R1174* S. 133 (11) State agencies shall consider the impact of their 134 actions on Civil War sites and structures as identified by the 135 commission whenever permitting, planning, funding or undertaking 136 any construction projects.

137 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 138 and after July 1, 2006.
