1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 3 2007.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying 7 8 salaries and defraying the expenses of the State Department of Audit in making the audits and investigations of public offices of 9 the state and counties as provided by Section 7-7-201 et seq., 10 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning 11 July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... \$ 12 5,863,661.00. 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special funds in the 14 15 State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Audit's 16 special fund account for the purpose of paying salaries and defraying the expenses of the State Department of Audit in making 17 18 the audits and investigations of public offices of the state and counties as provided by Section 7-7-201 et seq., Mississippi Code 19 20 of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending 21 June 30, 2007.....\$ 3,942,039.00. 22 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall 23 be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 24 expenditure: 25

Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 61 62 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 63 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 64 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 65 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 66 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 67 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 68 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 69 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 70 71 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 72 73 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 74 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 75 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 76 77 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 78 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 79

80 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 81 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 82 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 83 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 84 The 85 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 86 87 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 88 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 93 94 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 95 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 96 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 97 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 98 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 99 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 100 101 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 102 103 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 104 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 105 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 106 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 107 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 108 authorized in this act.

SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

132 SECTION 5. In addition to the sums appropriated herein, the 133 Office of the State Auditor is hereby authorized to receive, 134 budget and expend, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Administration, any special funds made available to comply 135 136 with the Single Audit Act of 1984. These special funds may be used to employ staff, and pay related expenses, or to engage 137 138 private accountants, as necessary, to comply with the provisions 139 of the act.

140 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 141 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 142 143 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 144 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 145 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 146 147 and after July 1, 2006.
