4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:	
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much there	of as may be
6	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special	
7	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available	
8	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi	
9	Department of Information Technology Services, for the fiscal year	
10	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the	provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be	
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of	
15	expenditure:

32	Funds are prov	ded herein to adjust the Variable Compensation	
33	Plan to ensure that	all full-time employees receive a pay increase

37	Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel		
38	Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds

49	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the		
50	Mississippi Legislat	ture. Based on data provided by the	
51	Legislative Budget (Office, the State Personnel Board shall	
52	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all		
53	appropriated position	ons in compliance with the provisions of this	
54	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure		
55	that no single perso	onnel action increases this projected annual	
56	cost and/or the Fisc	cal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal	
57	Services" when annua	alized, with the exception of escalated funds.	
58	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal		
59	Services," the State	e Personnel Board determines that the agency	
60	has taken an action	which would cause the agency to exceed this	
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- 61 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 62 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 63 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 64 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 65 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 67 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 68 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 69 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 70 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 71 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 72 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 73 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 74 appropriated level.
- 75 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 76 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 77 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 78 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 79 **SECTION 3.** In order to offset the cost of publishing the
- 80 annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory, the Mississippi
- 81 Department of Information Technology Services is hereby
- 82 authorized, empowered and directed, in its discretion, to offer
- 83 for advertising purposes, pages to be included in said Directory,
- 84 to accept bids, and to let contracts for said pages. The
- 85 contracts for said advertising purposes shall be let for definite
- 86 periods not to exceed two (2) years.
- It shall be the duty of the Mississippi Department of
- 88 Information Technology Services, if it is desired that advertising
- 89 shall be used, to approve all proposed advertising submitted for
- 90 use within such annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory.
- 91 The department is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in
- 92 its discretion, to reject any and all bids submitted, and if all
- 93 bids are rejected, the authority may negotiate a contract within

- 94 the limitations of the specifications so long as the terms of any
- 95 such negotiated contract are equal to or better than the
- 96 comparable terms submitted by the lowest and best bidder. No
- 97 sectarian, un-American, political, partisan or immoral
- 98 advertisement, as determined solely by the authority or its
- 99 successor, shall be accepted.
- 100 All monies derived from sale of such advertising shall be
- 101 deposited in the appropriate special fund in the State Treasury to
- 102 the credit of the Mississippi Department of Information Technology
- 103 Services.
- 104 **SECTION 4.** The Mississippi Department of Information
- 105 Technology Services is hereby authorized to receive additional
- 106 funds from any state agency or other source, including one hundred
- 107 percent (100%) general-fund agencies, for the purpose of providing
- 108 data processing or telecommunications services to any governmental
- 109 organization contracting with the Mississippi Department of
- 110 Information Technology Services for such services. The
- 111 Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services is
- 112 further authorized to escalate an amount not to exceed One Million
- 113 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and to increase, up to a maximum of twenty
- 114 (20) additional positions, the number of authorized positions
- 115 listed in this act in order to provide the required data
- 116 processing or telecommunications services for such governmental
- 117 organizations, under the rules and regulations of the Department
- 118 of Finance and Administration.
- 119 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 120 Section 1, One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) is
- 121 authorized for expenditure and for the established purpose of
- 122 E-Government Special Fund 3602.
- 123 **SECTION 6.** None of the funds herein appropriated shall be
- 124 expended by Information Technology Services unless assessments,
- 125 fees or rate levels charged to other state agencies for services
- 126 are at or below the January 1, 2006, fee structure level, except

127 for the establishment of rates for a new or expanded service, and 128 required increases due to costs not within the control of this 129 agency. 130 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 131 Department of Information Technology Services shall maintain 132 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 133 expenditure of all funds appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of 134 details as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the 135 136 intention of the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal 137 Year 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format 138 139 and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget 140 request process. It is the intention of the Legislature that the SECTION 8. 141 Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Information 142 143 Technology may authorize increases in major objects of expenditure 144 in total amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 145 146 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a 147 corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be 148 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits." 149 150 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 151 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 152 153 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 154 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 155 156 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2006.

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
