1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COMMERCE, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the State Department of Agriculture and
9	Commerce, including the Divisions of Support, Plant Industry and
LO	Farmers Central Market, for the fiscal year beginning
L1	July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007 \$ 7,547,542.00.
L2	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L3	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
L4	source funds, which are collected by or otherwise become available
L5	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Department
L6	of Agriculture and Commerce, including the Divisions of Support
L7	and Plant Industry and Farmers Central Market, for the fiscal year
L8	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
L9	\$ 5,493,121.00.
20	The funds authorized for expenditure under the provisions of
21	this section include subscription fees produced from the Market
22	Bulletin and admission fees produced from the Mississippi
23	Agriculture and Forestry Museum.
24	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
25	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

31	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
32	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase

36	Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel
37	Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds

- 79 expended under the provisions of this act shall be expended for
- 80 the purpose of defraying all expenses incurred by the State
- 81 Department of Agriculture and Commerce in the operation of all
- 82 programs and activities (except operation of the State Lime
- 83 Plants, Veterinary Laboratory, Pink Bollworm-Plant Quarantine
- 84 Inspection Stations and Fire Ant Program) authorized to be
- 85 conducted and carried on by said department; including, but not
- 86 limited to: the administration of the Feed, Fertilizer and Dairy
- 87 Act; the Weights and Measure Act; the Meat Inspection Act of 1968;
- 88 the Mississippi Pure Seed Law; and the following additional
- 89 programs and activities: enforcement of the egg law; publication
- 90 and distribution of the Mississippi Market Bulletin, agricultural
- 91 statistics, market news service at Stoneville, Mississippi; and
- 92 inspection, grading and certifying of fruits, vegetables, hay,

grain, meat and meat products, milk and dairy products, pecans, 93 94 seed and syrup. SECTION 5. 153	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
154	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
155	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
