SENATE BILL NO. 3032

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI FAIR 1 2 COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE DIXIE 3 NATIONAL LIVESTOCK SHOW; A ROUNDUP FOR JUNIOR EXHIBITORS OF 4 LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY; SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS FOR LIVESTOCK PREMIUMS; COUNTY LIVESTOCK SHOWS IN OFFERING AND PAYING PRIZES OR AWARDS TO 5 б COMPETITORS IN APPROVED COUNTY LIVESTOCK SHOWS; THE FIVE DISTRICT 7 LIVESTOCK SHOWS; THE FIVE STATE DAIRY SHOWS; THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH 8 SCHOOL RODEO; AND TO PROVIDE HOW SAID MONEY SHALL BE PAID OUT OF THE STATE TREASURY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007. 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 11 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 12 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Fair Commission's 13 special fund account, to the Mississippi Fair Commission for the 14 15 purposes of defraying the costs of prizes, premiums, judges and 16 other actual and necessary costs of putting on the Dixie National Livestock Show at the State Fairgrounds in Jackson, Mississippi, 17 18 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending 19 June 30, 2007\$ 934,150.00. 20 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be 36 necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 37 General Fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Fair Commission as follows: 38 For the support of annual roundup shows for junior 39 (a) exhibitors of junior steers, junior breeding cattle, beef cattle, 40 dairy cattle, hogs, sheep and poultry, for the fiscal year 41 beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 42 43\$ 69,720.00. 44 (b) To supplement the funds paid by the Mississippi Fair Commission for livestock premiums at the State Fair, all 45 livestock premiums to be paid on the American system of judging 46 47 (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, etc.) on all classes entered in the senior 48 division for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... \$ 49 26,997.00. 50 For the county livestock shows in offering and (C) 51 paying prizes or awards to competitors in the approved county 52 livestock shows of Mississippi, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... \$ 53 13,138.00. Provided, however, that of the amount herein appropriated in 54 55 subsection (c), not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be expended or used in any one county of the state during 56 57 each fiscal year. Provided, further, that none of the monies herein appropriated in subsection (c) shall be used in offering or 58 paying prizes or awards for any livestock show that is not held 59 where there are adequate barns, pens and other facilities 60 61 available for such a show. 62 Provided, further, in subsection (c) that the management of such shows shall be in the hands of a county livestock 63 *SS05/A434* S. 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64 association, and such association shall guarantee a minimum amount 65 of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be used in the paying of 66 prizes, premiums or awards, and after said county show has been 67 held and premiums paid, fifty percent (50%) of the amount, not 68 exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), shall be paid upon 69 requisition to the Mississippi Fair Commission.

Provided, further, in subsection (c) that in any county which has two (2) shows with proper facilities, and a contiguous county has no such fair and desires to participate in a fair to be held in an adjoining county, each of the two (2) fairs in one (1) county may receive an equal proportion of the funds hereby appropriated, provided, both shows shall not receive an aggregate sum of more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

81 (e) For the purpose of offering awards and prizes to
82 competitors in the five (5) state dairy shows as provided in
83 Section 69-5-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal
84 year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.....

Provided, further, that no part of the money herein 86 87 appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall 88 be used for any other purpose than to pay premium awards at said shows and state shows and expositions receiving legislative 89 90 appropriation shall not conflict in dates in order that livestock 91 exhibitors may make the circuit of shows. Provided, further, that none of the above mentioned funds shall be paid to any district 92 shows unless shows are held prior to roundup. 93

94 Not less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the funds herein 95 appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall 96 be used in awarding prizes or premiums to 4-H Club members and 5. B. No. 3032 *SS05/A434*

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97 Smith-Hughes School members and other boys and girls having98 entries in said shows.

All funds herein appropriated under the provisions of 99 100 subsections (d) and (e) for the five (5) district livestock shows 101 and the five (5) fall state dairy shows shall be distributed in 102 such manner that the livestock exhibitors will each draw equal 103 premium awards for comparable grades and placings at each of the said five (5) district spring shows and the five (5) fall state 104 105 The management of each district spring show and each state shows. 106 fall show shall submit to the Mississippi Fair Commission, within 107 fifteen (15) days after the close of each said show, a full report on the number of exhibitors at each said show, with the grades and 108 109 placings of the different classes of livestock exhibited.

The Executive Secretary of the Mississippi Fair Commission, 110 together with a committee of three (3) to be named by the 111 President of the Mississippi Livestock Council from that 112 113 organization, shall summarize and prepare a unified list of awards 114 for like classes in all spring district livestock shows and fall state dairy shows receiving state premium money, as authorized in 115 116 subsections (d) and (e). The Executive Secretary and Chairman of 117 the Mississippi Fair Commission shall approve and present a 118 requisition to the State Fiscal Officer for the payment of the amount of funds in subsections (d) and (e) due each show and said 119 State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrant thereon, and it shall 120 121 be paid by the State Treasurer.

Provided, however, as a condition of expenditure of the funds 122 123 appropriated in subsections (d) and (e), that the board of directors of any district livestock show may, in its discretion, 124 choose to hold its show in the fall instead of the spring. 125 Ιf 126 district shows are held in both spring and fall, then all funds 127 herein appropriated for the five (5) district livestock shows 128 shall be distributed in such a manner that the spring livestock 129 exhibitors will each draw equal premium awards for comparable *SS05/A434* S. 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130 grades and placings at each district spring show, and the fall 131 livestock exhibitors will each draw equal premium awards for 132 comparable grades and placings at each district fall show.

(f) For promotion and expenses of the winners of the
Mississippi High School Rodeo for attending the national finals,
for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending

SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of Fund 3435 in the State Treasury for the award prizes of the Traditional Groom Competition and support of annual roundup shows for junior exhibitors of junior steers, junior breeding cattle, beef cattle, dairy cattle, hogs, sheep and poultry, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007......\$ 12,000.00

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 144 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 145 146 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 147 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 148 149 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 150 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 151 and after July 1, 2006.
