AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE 1 2 EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI FAIR COMMISSION, THE MISSISSIPPI LIVESTOCK COLISEUM AND THE INDUSTRIAL SHOWCASE AND TRADE MART 3 4 BUILDING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 7 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Fair Commission 8 9 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said Mississippi Fair 10 Commission, the Mississippi Livestock Coliseum, the Industrial Showcase, the Trade Mart Building and for the purpose of paying 11 any indebtedness which may accrue for the period beginning 12 July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... \$ 13 4,049,158.00. 14 SECTION 2. Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 46 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 47 48 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 49 50 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 51 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 52 53 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 54 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 55 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 56 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 57 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 58 59 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 60 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 61 \*SS05/A430\* S. has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 68 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 69 70 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 71 72 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 73 74 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 75 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 76 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

81 SECTION 3. No operation, maintenance or service contracts, 82 agreements or obligations for commodities, concessions, or 83 catering services, shall be entered into or renewed by this agency 84 for a period of more than three (3) years nor unless said 85 contracts, agreements or obligations have been made in accordance 86 with Sections 31-7-11, 31-7-13, 31-7-55 and 31-7-57, Mississippi 87 Code of 1972.

88 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and 89 authorized for expenditure in Section 2, it is the intention of 90 the Legislature that Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) shall be 91 transferred to the Fair Commission - County Livestock Shows during 92 the Fiscal Year 2007.

93 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 94 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the S. B. No. 3033 \*SS05/A430\* 06/SS05/A430 PAGE 3 95 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 96 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 97 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 98 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 99 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 100 and after July 1, 2006.
