4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Institute for Forest
8	Inventory which is comprised of special source funds and donations
9	collected by or otherwise available to the Institute for the
10	purpose of defraying the expenses of the Institute for the period
11	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
12	\$ 295,142.00.
13	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
14	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
15	under the authority of the State Personnel Board:
16	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
17	Permanent: Full Time 3
18	Part Time 0
19	Time-Limited: Full Time

21	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
22	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
23	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
24	Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater,
25	beginning on July 1, 2006.
26	Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel
27	Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds

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    available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006
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    agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result
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    in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another
    employee within the same agency, with the same job classification
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    series and greater longevity.
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         With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
    the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
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    make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
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    Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
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    funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
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    are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
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    Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
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    Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
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    determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
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    appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
          It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
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    that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
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    cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
    Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
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    If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
    Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
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    has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
    projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
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    appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
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    reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
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    requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
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    such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
         Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
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    the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
    allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
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    Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
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    approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
    Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
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- 61 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 62 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 63 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 65 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 66 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 67 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 68 **SECTION 3.** This appropriation is made for the purpose of
- 69 providing funds to defray the expenses of the Mississippi
- 70 Institute for Forest Inventory as established in Section
- 71 49-19-403, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 72 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 73 Mississippi Institute for Forest Inventory is hereby authorized to
- 74 accept, budget and expend funds, not to exceed One Million Dollars
- 75 (\$1,000,000.00), from any source in accordance with rules and
- 76 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a
- 77 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 78 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 79 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
- 80 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
- 81 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
- 82 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
- 83 in the manner provided by law.
- 84 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 85 and after July 1, 2006.
