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| 6 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: |
| 7 | SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 8 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State |
| 9 | General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of |
| LO | defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management |
| L1 | Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et |
| L2 | seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning |

| L4 | SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |

- 68 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 69 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 70 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
- 71 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 72 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 73 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 74 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 75 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 76 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 77 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 78 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 79 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 81 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 82 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 83 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 84 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 85 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 86 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 87 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 88 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 90 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 91 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 92 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 93 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 94 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency may, upon

an area which has suffered a natural disaster, supply equipment to rural water associations to enable their continued operation when

the request of a local public emergency management organization in

- 98 the local emergency management organization determines that such
- 99 private entities provide services essential to the welfare of the
- 100 community.

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- 101 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 102 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency shall
- 103 provide enhanced training to local governments, supervisors,
- 104 mayors, civil defense groups and municipal associations in

None of the funds appropriated in Section 6 163 shall be used to establish a special reserve fund in the State 164 Treasury for disaster relief except as provided for in Sections 165 43-41-1 et seq. and 43-41-301 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 166 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 167 168 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 169 170 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 171 172 Executive Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency 173 may authorize increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the 174 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 175 176 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a 177 corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 178 179 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits." SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 180 181 Executive Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency shall have authority to transfer not more than Five Hundred 182 Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) from any general or special fund 183 184 treasury fund and major object budget category to another special or general fund treasury fund and major object budget category 185 186 accordingly under the control of the Mississippi Emergency 187 Management Agency. The purpose of this authority is to more efficiently use available cash reserves. It is further the 188 intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the 189 190 Mississippi Emergency Management Agency shall submit written 191 justification for the transfer to the Legislative Budget Office 192 and the Department of Finance and Administration on or before the

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- 193 fifteenth (15th) of the month prior to the effective date of the 194 transfer.
- 195 **SECTION 14.** The expenditure of the funds appropriated by
- 196 this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be
- 197 paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or
- 198 funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State
- 199 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
- 200 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
- 201 officers in the manner provided by law.
- 202 **SECTION 15.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 203 and after July 1, 2006.
