1 2	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
7	defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans Affairs
8	Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending
9	June 30, 2007\$ 2,939,184.00.
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
12	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs
13	Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or
14	otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance
15	of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and
16	ending June 30, 2007\$ 24,233,095.00.
17	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
18	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
19	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
20	expenditure:

41	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
42	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
43	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
44	Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater,
45	beginning on July 1, 2006.
46	Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel
47	Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds
48	available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006
49	agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result
50	in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another
51	employee within the same agency, with the same job classification
52	series and greater longevity.
53	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
54	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
55	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
56	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
57	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
58	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
59	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
60	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
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determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
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- 63 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 64 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 65 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
- 66 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 67 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 68 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 69 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 70 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 71 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 72 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 73 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 74 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 75 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 76 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 77 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 78 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 79 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 80 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 81 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 82 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 83 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 85 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 86 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 87 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 88 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 89 Sections 1 and 2, funds in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty
- 90 Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of
- 91 providing care to indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans and the
- 92 non-veteran surviving spouses of Mississippi veterans if the
- 93 surviving spouse was a resident of a state veterans home at the

- 94 time of the veteran's death and who, subsequent to the veteran's
- 95 death, meets the indigent/low-income criteria established by the
- 96 State Veterans Affairs Board, in the state veterans homes. It is
- 97 the intention of the Legislature that the provision pertaining to
- 98 use of indigent/low-income surviving spouses be retroactive for
- 99 any such period, prior to the effective date of this act, that a
- 100 current surviving spouse may have met the criteria. This section
- 101 and its provisions shall be known and cited as the "Hilton R.
- 102 'Jack' Vance Act of 1997."
- 103 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 104 Section 2, Four Hundred Eighty-seven Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty
- 105 Dollars (\$487,750.00) shall be derived from the Health Care
- 106 Expendable Fund created in Section 43-13-407, Mississippi Code of
- 107 1972, for the support and maintenance of the Veterans' Affairs
- 108 Board.
- 109 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 110 Executive Director of the Veterans' Affairs Board may authorize
- 111 increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts
- 112 not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount
- 113 of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major
- 114 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar
- 115 amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase
- 116 the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe
- 117 Benefits."
- 118 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 119 Veterans Affairs Board shall maintain complete accounting and
- 120 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 121 appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such
- 122 records shall be in the same format and level of details as
- 123 maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of
- 124 the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall
- 125 be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 126 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 127 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 128 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 129 130 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 131 132 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 133 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 134

and after July 1, 2006.

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
