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| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as |
| 6 | may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the |
| 7 | State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Banking |
| 8 | and Consumer Finance, for the support of the State Department of |
| 9 | Banking and Consumer Finance, for the fiscal year beginning |
| LO | July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007 |
| L1 | \$ 5,279,097.00. |
| L2 | SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions |
| L3 | of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: |

| L5 | Permanent: Full Time 54 |
| L6 | Part Time 0 |
| L7 | Time-Limited: Full Time 0 |
| L8 | Part Time 0 |
| L9 | Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation |
| 20 | Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase |
| 21 | equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation |
| 22 | Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, |
| 23 | beginning on July 1, 2006. |

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 31 32 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 33 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 34 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 36 37 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 38 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 40 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 41 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 43 44 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 45 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 46 47 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 48 49 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 50 51 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 52 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 53 54 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 55 56 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 57 58 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written

approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

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- 60 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 61 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 63 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 64 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 65 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 66 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 67 Banking and Consumer Finance shall maintain complete accounting
- 68 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 69 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 70 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 71 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 72 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to
- 73 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 74 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 75 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.
- 76 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 77 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 78 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 79 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 80 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 81 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 82 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 83 and after July 1, 2006.
