4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

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Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater,

34 beginning on July 1, 2006.

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Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 42 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 43 44 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 45 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 46 47 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 48 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 49 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 50 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 51 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 52 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 53 54 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 55 56 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 57 58 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 59 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 60 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which *SS05/A824* S. 61 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 62 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 63 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 66 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 67 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 68 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 69 70 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 71 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 72

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

77 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 78 of the funds appropriated in this act shall be authorized for the 79 purchase of surveillance equipment.

80 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 81 82 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 83 84 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 85 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 86 87 and after July 1, 2006.

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
