## SENATE BILL NO. 3050

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 STATE TREASURY TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI MOTOR 2 VEHICLE COMMISSION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as 5 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 6 7 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Motor Vehicle 8 Commission, as provided by Section 63-17-51 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said 9 Commission, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending 10 June 30, 2007.....\$ 285,513.00. 11 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 12 13 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 14 15 expenditure: 16 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: Personal Services: 17 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 18 193,499.00 Travel and Subsistence..... 19 25,000.00 20 Contractual Services..... 58,014.00 21 Commodities..... 6,000.00 22 Capital Outlay: 0.00 23 Other Than Equipment..... 3,000.00 24 Equipment..... Subsidies, Loans and Grants..... 0.00 25 26 Total.....\$ 285,513.00 27 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 44 45 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 46 47 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 48 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 49 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 50 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 51 52 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 53 54 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 55 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 56 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 57 58 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 59 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 60 \*SS05/A839\* S. 06/SS05/A839 PAGE 2 61 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 62 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 63 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 64 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 65 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

66 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 67 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 69 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 70 The 71 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 72 73 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 74 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

**SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act shall be expended to defray any expenses of the Motor Vehicle Commission if said commission takes any official actions during Fiscal Year 2007 that serve directly or indirectly to reduce the payment to the State General Fund of any sales tax on motor vehicles sold within the State of Mississippi.

It is further the intention of the Legislature that if such 86 87 actions are taken by the Motor Vehicle Commission during Fiscal Year 2007, the executive director and commission members shall be 88 held personally liable for repayment of any funds expended under 89 the provisions of this act with said repayment to be made to the 90 91 State General Fund. The Attorney General is hereby authorized and 92 directed to undertake appropriate legal action to enforce the provisions of this act and to recover said funds. 93

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94 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 95 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 96 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 97 98 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 99 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 100 and after July 1, 2006. 101
