SENATE BILL NO. 3052 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI PROFESSIONAL 3 COUNSELOR LICENSING BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Professional Counselor Licensing Board, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007......\$ 108,436.00.

11 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 12 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 17 18 Professional Counselors Licensing Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 19 20 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 21 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 22 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 23 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 24 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 25 26 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

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SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that 27 28 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 29 30 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 31 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 32 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 33 34 made without competitive bids.

35 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 36 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 37 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 38 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 39 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 40 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 41 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from

42 and after July 1, 2006.
